5 Antioch—Ps 2, Hab 1:5, Is 42: 49:6, 55
David's Seed. Savior Jesus. God has fulfilled.
Raised & seen. The Promise. Sure mercies.
Forgiveness of sins to everyone who believes.
Not by law. Jews envy, persecute. Gentiles glad.
Iconium—many believe, joy, Holy S. Violent
persecution. Bold in Lord Who bear witness.
Fled to **Lystra**—Lame healed. Seen as gods.
Preach Living God. Jews stone Paul. **Derbe**.
Many disciples. **Return to Lystra, Iconium,
& Antioch.** Strengthening souls of disciples.
Faith. "We must through many tribulations enter
the Kingdom of God." Appoint elders, pray, fast.
Commend them to the Lord. To **Pisidia**.

Through Pisidia to Pamphylia,
Preached the word in Perga. To Attalia.

4 John Mark back
to Jerusalem.

7 Back to Antioch—
Reported all God did,
that He opened
the door of faith
to the Gentiles.
Stayed a long time
with disciples.

3 Sorcerer, a false prophet, a Jew, Bar-Jesus, with Proconsul Sergius Paulus, who sought to hear the word of God. But Elymas (sorcerer) withstood them, seeking to turn him from the faith. Paul filled with the Holy Spirit "O full of all deceit & all fraud, you son of the devil, you enemy of all righteousness, will you not cease perverting straight ways of the Lord? Hand of the Lord is upon you. Blind, dark mist fell on him. The proconsul believed when he saw, astonished at the teaching of the Lord.

w Herod tetrarch (Antipas),
& Saul. As they ministered
to the Lord & fasted.
Holy Spirit—"Now separate
to Me Barnabas & Saul
