



9 Ch 17 Great multitude join. Jews envy cause attack of Jason's house seeking Paul, Silas.

10 Fair minded Jewish Bereans received word, search scripture daily. Many believed, & Gent.

11 Paul to Areopagus philosophers. Proclaim Unknown God in Athens, Who determines boundaries. That they seek & find Him. Repent. Judgment. Jesus raised. Some believe.

Ch 18 Paul meets Aquila & Priscilla. Ant. B 18,3,5 - Jews out of Rome.

12 Persuades Jews & Greeks. Jews oppose & blaspheme. "Your blood on your own heads, I am clean. I will go to Gentiles."

Jesus encourages Paul to speak. 1.5yr teaching the word of God. Gallio. 50/51AD 1&2 Thessalonians written at Corinth. Leaves Priscilla & Aquila at Ephesus. Reasons w Jews, asking him to stay. To Caesarea, Jerusalem, Antioch.

Acts 15:36-18:22
Delivering decrees of apostles & elders.
Churches strengthened in faith, increase.

Circumcision Conflict
Paul & Barnabas through Phoenicia, Samaria, to Jerusalem.
Acts 15

Jerusalem Council
Some believing Pharisees command circumcision/law. Peter-a good while ago Gentiles hear/believe. No distinction Purified hearts by faith, saved in same manner by Jesus. Barnabas, Paul declare works of God among Gentiles. James- "Simeon declared how God at the first visited Gentiles...people for His name. Prophets agree, Amos 9. Don't trouble Gentiles turning to God. Church pleased. Abstain from things offered to idols, from blood, from things strangled, & from sexual immorality. If you keep yourselves from these, you will do well.
