Antiochus 175-170BC

Antiochus IV, uncle to these 3 Egyptian rulers. Stopped by Romans-Gaius Popilius Laenas, line in sand.

Antiochus I Sotor 281-261BC

Seleucus II Callinicus 246-225BC

Antiochus III The Great 223-187BC gave to Ptolemy V for advantage, daughter Cleopatra I (193-176BC)

Seleucus IV Philopater killed by Heliodorus. Son of Antiochus III 187-175BC

Demetrius Sotor to Rome as hostage son of Seleucus IV 162-150-BC

Mithridates Antiochus IV Epiphanes 175-164BC

Antiochus II Theos 261-246BC Killed by 1st wife Laodice, Berenice & son also killed.

Seleucus III Ceraunus 225-223BC

Battle of Raphia 217BC

Ptolemy III Euergetes 246-222BC War on Laodice & son Seleucus II

Ptolemy VI Philometor 180-164 163-145BC

Ptolemy VIII Euergetes II "Fatty" 170-164, 145-131, 127-116BC

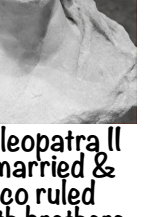
Cleopatra II married & co ruled with brothers & daughter Cleopatra III. 175-164, 131-127 124-115BC

Ptolemy I Soter 305-282BC Alexander's most trusted leader. Built library of Alexandria.

1550 Antonio Tempesta-Expulsion of Heliodorus from the temple.

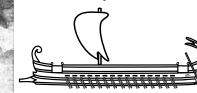


Cleopatra VII ruled 51-30BC She had a son by Julius Caesar 47BC. She had 3 children by Mark Antony afterward.

Daniel 11:20 "There shall arise in his place one who imposes taxes on the glorious kingdom; but within a few days he shall be destroyed, but not in anger or in battle. 21 "And in his place shall arise a vile person, to whom they will not give the honor or royalty; but he shall come in peaceably, and sieze the kingdom by intrigue.

Heliodorus - chancellor of Seleucus IV, gathered tax, killed him & took control. He vanished when Antiochus IV came.

Antiochus IV took custody of his young brother Antiochus, who was ruler. Antiochus IV later killed his brother, and took control.
