Matthew 21:33 ...There was a certain landowner who planted a vineyard and set a hedge around it, dug a winepress in it and built a tower. And he leased it to vinedressers and went into a far country. **34** "Now when vintage-time drew near, he sent his servants to the vinedressers, that they might receive its fruit. **35** "And the vinedressers took his servants, beat one, killed one, and stoned another. **36** "Again he sent other servants, more than the first, and they did likewise to them. **37** "Then last of all he sent his son to them, saying, 'They will respect my son.' **38** "But when the vinedressers saw the son, they said among themselves, 'This is the heir. Come, let us kill him and seize his inheritance.' **39** "So they took him and cast him out of the vineyard and killed him. **40** "Therefore, when the owner of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those vinedressers?" **41** They said to Him, "He will destroy those wicked men miserably, and lease his vineyard to other vinedressers who will render to him the fruits in their seasons." **42** Jesus said to them, "Have you never read in the Scriptures: 'The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone. This was the LORD's doing, And it is marvelous in our eyes'?" (Psalm 118) **43** "Therefore I say to you, the kingdom of God will be taken from you and given to a nation bearing the fruits of it. **44** "And whoever falls on this stone will be broken; but on whomever it falls, it will grind him to powder." **45** Now when the chief priests and Pharisees heard His parables, they perceived that He was speaking of them.

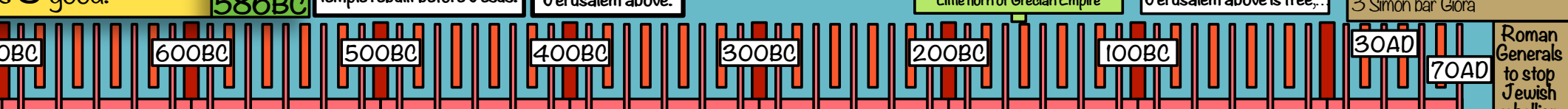
