

Josiah (Last good king. Killed by Pharaoh Necho II at Megiddo 609BC).
Jehoahaz (Shallum arrested by Pharaoh Necho II to Egypt).
Jehoiakim (Eliakim placed by Necho II, cut & burned prophecies. Died before Babylon came. **Jer 36:32**).
Jehoiachin (Jeconiah. Captive to Babylon, released 37th yr.)
Zedekiah (Mattaniah, blinded, chained, captive to Babylon).
607BC Babylon's **Nebuchadnezzar II** conquers Assyria.
605BC Nebuchadnezzar II conquers Necho II at Carchemish.
597BC **Jehoiachin** to Babylon. **Zedekiah** set as king. Ezekiel & others to Babylon.
586BC **Jerusalem/temple destroyed, captive.**
582/581BC? Ishmael murders Gedaliah, governor. Flee to Egypt.

Jer 5:5 ...but these have altogether broken the yoke, burst the bonds.
6 Wherefore a lion out of the forest shall slay them, a wolf of the evenings shall spoil them, a leopard shall watch over their cities: everyone that goeth out shall be torn to pieces: because their transgressions are many, and their backslidings are increased.

Jer 6:8 Be instructed O Jerusalem, Lest My soul depart from thee; lest I make thee desolate, a land not inhabited.

Jer 2:26 "As the thief is ashamed when he is found out, so is the house of Israel ashamed; They and their kings and their princes, and their priests and their prophets,
27 Saying to a tree, "You are my father," And to a stone, "You gave birth to me. For they have turned their back to Me, and not their face..."

Jer 3:8 ...backsliding Israel had committed adultery, I had put her away with a bill of divorce; yet her treacherous (covert) sister Judah feared not, but went and played the harlot also.

Jer 4:1...Return unto Me; and if thou wilt put away thine abominations out of My sight, then thou shalt not be moved.
14 O Jerusalem, wash thine heart from wickedness, That thou mayest be saved....

Jer 25:12....Then it will come to pass, when 70 years are completed, that I will punish the king of Babylon.... I will make it a perpetual desolation.

Jeremiah faces false prophet Hananiah **Jer 28:13**...."You have broken the yokes of wood, but you have made in their place yokes of iron."

Jer 2:33 "Why do you beautify your way to seek love? Therefore you have also taught the wicked women your ways.
34 Also on your skirt is found the blood of the lives of the poor innocents. I have not found it by secret search, but plainly on all these things.

Jer 24:8 'And as the bad figs which cannot be eaten, they are so bad'-surely thus says the Lord-'so will I give up Zedekiah the king of Judah, his princes, the residue of Jerusalem who remain in this land, and those who dwell in the land of Egypt.

Jer 7:28...This is a nation that obeys not the voice of the LORD their God, nor receives correction: truth is perished, & is cut off from their mouth.

Jer 7:9 Will ye steal, murder, commit adultery, swear falsely, burn incense to Baal, & walk after other gods whom ye know not; **10** And come stand before Me in this house, which is called by My Name, and say We are delivered to do all these abominations?

A fortified city. I am with you to deliver you.

Jer 1:18 For behold, I have made thee this day a fortified city, and an iron pillar, and bronze walls against the whole land, against kings of Judah, princes, priests, people of the land. **19** They shall fight against thee: but they shall not prevail against thee; for I am with thee, saith the LORD, to deliver thee.

Jer 23:29 "Is not My word like a fire?" says the LORD, "And like a hammer that breaks the rock in pieces?"

Jer 1:8 Be not afraid of their faces, for I am with thee to deliver thee,....

Jer 29:10...After 70 years are completed at Babylon, I will visit you and perform My good word toward you, and cause you to return to this place.
11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

Jer 3:22 Return you backsliding children, and I will heal your backslidings.

Jeremiah - Ordained a prophet to nations. 13th yr Josiah - 11th yr Zedekiah. Baruch - his secretary. **Jer 36:32**

James 1:18 Of His own will He brought us forth by the word of truth, that we might be a kind of firstfruits of His creatures.

In those days at that time I will cause the Branch of Righteous to grow up unto David; and He shall execute judgment & righteousness in the land. **Jer 33:15**

Jeremiah 9:24 But let him who glories glory in this, that he understands and knows Me, that I am the LORD, exercising lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth. For in these I delight," says the LORD.

Accuse Jeremiah of lies. Jeremiah hides stones at Pharaoh's entrance. Nebuchadnezzar will burn temples in Egypt. **43.** Judgment **44.** Baruch. **45.** Egypt, Pharaoh Necho II, Ethiopians, Libyans, Lydians. (**46**). Philistines, Tyre, Sidon, Caphtor, Gaza, Ashkelon, (**47**). Moab (**48**). Ammon, (Molech), Edom, Damascus, Kedar, Hazor, Elam, (**49**).
